

It has been written by professional Australian astrologer Stephanie Johnson, who has been studying the stars and the energetic influence of the planets for 30 plus years and is still learning.



The Sun

Sun Sign Astrology is very popular in modern times. Many people know their own Sun Sign. And it has become a common occurrence for personal introductions to include a reference to a person's Sun Sign. Just as the Sun is the centre of the earth's Solar System, so does the Sun play a vital role in your life on earth. Your personality and self-expression are linked to your Sun - its Zodiac Sign and its position in your chart. So, it's no wonder that Sun Signs have risen in recognition.

The Sun moves around the Zodiac every year and so you share your birthday and Sun Sign with many others. You can see enough similarities to pique your interest in astrology. It's important to note the Sun isn't the only planet to be considered in a person's chart, but it is an important component.

The Sun gives you an indication of how you can shine in your life. You feel truly alive when you're living the traits indicated by your Sun. Therefore, it's likely that you will spend much of your life on a journey to self-discovery, aiming to incorporate these traits into your life. Understanding the energy of your Sun is a good starting point to understanding yourself. Esoteric Astrology, or the astrology of the soul, also states that your Sun Sign is your personality, and is only a vehicle to your soul purpose which is indicated by your Ascendant or Rising Sign.

The Sun is in Scorpio

Your Sun is in the Zodiac Sign of Scorpio indicating that you're a passionate and intense individual, who likes to experience life at a very deep level. None of the superficial skating over life's surface for you. You like to penetrate life's mysteries and the intricacies of personal relationships. You demand an intimacy and honesty in your life that can be challenging to others. For this reason, you may experience the crisis of loss as you frighten other people away with your intensity. However, you will soon become an expert at dealing with these crises and you will discover an ability to attract other individuals who treasure your ability to face life honestly. In fact, you're an excellent counsellor as you're insightful and not frightened of tackling the minefield of emotions which surround subjects such as death, sexuality and metaphysical experiences. Ironically while you demand soul bearing from others, there is a secretive side of yourself, which means that you may be somewhat of a mystery to those around you. Scorpio is a Water Sign which means that you do have a strong emotional nature, which if violated can spark the scorpion in you. You can freeze out loved ones if you believe that you have been wronged. Coming to terms with this side of your nature is one of your challenges in life. Fortunately, you're also resourceful, well able to find what is needed to survive and thrive. This is particularly true in financial matters, as long you trust your instincts and trust the right people. You learn to know the right place to search for information, or the right person to approach.

Let's explore your talents as a Scorpio Sun Sign. Who needs a lie detector machine when you are around? You have a natural radar for the truth, the emotional truth. People may fool themselves but not you. As such,

you have a natural talent as a detective, counsellor, mediator, and social worker. Your gift of perception may also extend to an aptitude for being psychic. You could explore tarot, astrology, mediumship or other metaphysical pursuits. You are resourceful and gifted in managing people and projects. You are also good with money. Given the right circumstances, you can be a money magnet, well able to manifest what you need and more. Research is also in your list of talents. You could excel in medical research, or surgery, as you have a great ability to concentrate on essentials. You also have a gift for helping people who are going through a crisis, physical or emotional. Your talents can extend to crisis or mental health counselling, ambulance or paramedic work, or emergency department nursing.

And now to your love life. The planet of love Venus is strongly linked to your love life, as are some other key points in your Birth Chart. However, your Sun Sign also plays a role. Your Sun Sign is how you express yourself as an individual and also within relationships. As a Scorpio you have deep feelings about most things, your marriage relationship being one of the most important. Therefore, you are very discriminating when it comes to your love life. You know that you become deeply involved and so you are likely to hold your cards close to your chest while assessing any potential partner. A sexual spark is necessary, but you also need to feel a rapport on an emotional level as well. Therefore, it could be a case of opposites attract with a Taurus. On the other hand, you may find true love with a fellow Scorpio, Cancer or Pisces. You are likely to share some common ground with a Virgo, as you are both cautious and discerning individuals. Likewise, your Capricorn partner could be a stable force. Air Signs and Fire Signs – Gemini, Libra, Aquarius, Aries, Leo and Sagittarius are less likely to be compatible.

Self-care is something that is important. Naturally, life's challenges need to be faced but there is also a need to occasionally escape when problems seem overwhelming. Escape is defined as 'breaking free of confinement or control'. In this instance, 'escape' is from the confinement of seemingly insurmountable obstacles of 21st Century living. How do you like to get away? And what type of self-care helps revive you and support your personality? Perhaps you will recognise yourself in your Sun Sign, and you may discover further tips by reading your Moon Sign in the next section of this report. Scorpio is a Water Sign, so you may be better at looking after your loved ones rather than taking care of yourself. Luckily, you are a resourceful person, so, you can appreciate the need to make sure that you are nourished in all ways, so that you can then take care of the people in your inner circle. Occasionally listening to other people's problems can help you put your own into perspective, but you need to find other ways to practice self-care. You may find your escape in a water activity such as swimming, snorkelling, diving or sailing. You may also enjoy activities that are associated with cold weather such as skiing, ice-skating and such like. The active planet Mars is the ruler of your Zodiac Sign and so a more active water sports such as motorboat racing or surfing may also provide an excellent means of escape. Curling up in an armchair and reading the latest mystery crime novel could also appeal. You need to find your escape through an activity that is emotionally satisfying.

Now let's look at some of the drawbacks of your Sun Sign and how to turn them into strengths. Everyone has weaknesses. One of life's challenges is to accept our weaknesses, and then to see how they are a flip side to our strengths. We can then be our authentic selves. And, as such we can trust that a higher power is guiding us to use both our weaknesses and strengths for a higher purpose.

As a Scorpio, you are astute. The word 'astute' is defined as 'having or showing an ability to accurately assess situations or people and turn this to one's advantage'. Your ability to be astute is often accompanied by strong feelings. Scorpio is a Water Sign and emotions are a powerful influence. When you are at peace then you can use your intelligence well in situations that demand shrewd action. Crisis management, conflict resolution, medical and psychological analysis and research are just a few areas in which your strengths shine. However, you need to ensure that you are soul centred. Sins, to use an old-fashioned word, such as envy, wrath and lust need to be avoided. In other words, you need to use your insights for the good of others, as much as for yourself. Then any weaknesses are overcome and become strengths that empower you and those with whom you connect.

The Sun is in the 2nd Face of Scorpio

Sun Sign Astrology has become so popular that people now introduce themselves by announcing their own Sun Sign. For instance, "hello, I am Steph and I am a Sagittarius, so I am usually pretty upbeat and positive". In this way the traits of a Sun Sign are claimed, owned and exchanged as accurate personal information. But did you know that your Sun Sign can be further dissected into three separate parts, called Decans. Decans are a system in which astrologers allocate different planets to every ten degrees of each Zodiac Sign. These Decans are sometimes referred to as Face. The Decans, or Face, date back as far as the 3rd Millennium BC, and are still used by astrologers in current times. Each Decan influences your Zodiac Sign in different ways, sometimes emphasising and sometimes adding a different flavour to your Zodiac Sign traits. You may like to look up the exact degrees of your Sun Sign so that you know if your Sun is in the 1st, 2nd or 3rd Decan. The first ten degrees equals the 1st Decan, the second ten degrees the 2nd and the third the 3rd Decan. The approximate dates for Scorpio are: Scorpio Decan 1: October 23 to November 1 Scorpio Decan 2: November 2 to November 11 Scorpio Decan 3: November 12 to November 21.

Trust is a major theme when you are born in this Scorpio Decan. Early life lessons surround who you can and can't trust, perhaps with a betrayal of a loved one teaching you the hard way. As you mature you learn to discern who you can trust, although ultimately your greatest lesson is to trust yourself. The traditional ruler of this Decan is the Sun, which is what triggers your vulnerability. The Sun does not shine brightly in the Sign of Scorpio and so you are susceptible to those who try to undermine your confidence. The modern terminology, 'gaslighting' is something that you need to be wary of. Gaslighting is described as (someone) using psychological methods that manipulate people to question their own sanity or powers of reasoning. This is where self-trust comes in. You are like a young child at heart, and you need to protect this susceptible part of yourself. Isolation is not the answer. You could find an avenue to express your inner most feelings. Acting, music, poetry and the like are some suggestions. When you find a person, or people, who you can trust then you are loyal and steadfast, particularly in your closest relationship. You are also astute, having learn key lessons early in life. Therefore, you can excel in politics, business and psychology. You may also be drawn to metaphysical matters.

The Sun is in the 2nd House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Sun, it's also prudent to look at where your Sun is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. Your Sun is in the 2nd House of your Birth Chart meaning that you're the sort of person who spends much of your life exploring your personal values. It's important for you to have a set of values by which you can judge your own and others' lives, as long as you don't become too critical when either you or others fail to live up to your expectations. If you're too critical then you will find that your self-esteem suffers, as you worry about your own failures or others become fed up with your harsh attitude. On a more positive note, you are more likely to have an upbeat approach to monetary matters. You are the type of person who knows your own value and can keep your word. Your self-esteem thrives when you handle finances well. You are likely to be the household money manager, enjoying the role of balancing the budget. Money, and the pleasures that it can afford, are attractive to you. You may expend much of your time and energy earning money in order to build yourself up, or to buy possessions that help you feel secure. The challenge is to value yourself no matter what your external circumstances are. However, you're likely to benefit financially through generous benefactors, possibly your father or a member of your father's side of the family. You could also benefit financially through a career that involves money such as accounting, book keeping, banking, and advising.

The Moon

Astrologers from different schools of thought allocate varying meanings to the Moon in a Birth Chart. Ancient astrologers say that the Moon changes its nature according to its phases, and merely passes on impressions from other planets rather than directly influencing a person's life. In other words, the Moon is said to reflect the light of other planets, emphasising them or shading them.

Modern astrologers tell us that the Moon depicts a person's roots, our home and family. They say the Moon also shows our habitual nature or subconscious patterns of behaviour which stand in the way of achieving our life goals. Modern astrology advises understanding our emotion nature and with it so that we can express our needs in a positive way.

Another form, Esoteric Astrology or astrology of the soul, tells us that the Moon represent the past, the obstacles that we need to overcome so that we can fulfil our soul's purpose. The Moon, according to Esoteric Astrology, is our past karma that blocks our soul's progress. So they suggest suppressing our needs as depicted by the Moon.

The approach in this report is that while the Moon can show us our strengths, it can also depict our weaknesses which need to be overcome in order to be successful in life.

The Moon is in Libra

With the Moon in the sign of Libra you love and appreciate beauty, and would prefer to share this appreciation with your loved ones. Not for you sitting alone on a hillside watching the hues of the sunset. You want your loved one close by your side. This enjoyment of others' company plays a major role in your life, and you may have some difficulty spending time on your own. However, you'll find that you've a good understanding of relationships and what makes them work, and what makes them fail. You also have an innate ability to please others, to create harmony, and to enjoy social occasions. You may find that you enjoy organising social functions. You're a people-watcher, enjoying noticing what makes them tick. You need to remember though that spending time by yourself and doing things for yourself is important. For you're likely to have creative talents which need developing. This could range from literally artistic talents, to the ability to create beautiful surroundings such as interior decorating or flower arranging.

Money matters. Whether you like it or not money is needed to survive in the 21st century. And everyone has a money story that has been passed on down through their family history, and is in situ when born. This could be a story of struggle, comfort or riches. As your money journey unfolds, and then later the story unravels, it's likely to have emotions associated with it. The Moon is the seat of emotions and so is intricately linked to your money story, and resultant money mindset. Money is often the exchange of

emotions, and vice versa emotions affect how money flows. In learning more about your emotions, and their link to money, you can step into a more positive and powerful place in your life, and experience the flow of money that you most desire. Understanding your Moon Sign in your Horoscope can accelerate this process. Like most areas of your life, it's always about finding the right balance. When the financial scales are tipped in your favour you enjoy spending the fruits of your labour. Retail therapy is soothing for anyone with a Libra Moon. You enjoy the flow of money as it comes in, and you like to circulate it purchasing your own lovely possessions, and gifting items to others. You feel that life is good. But when your budget is limited, or worse in the red, then you are stressed. You do not enjoy the scales being weighed down at the debt end. For this reason, you need to avoid money pitfalls such as after pay, credit card debt, too-good-to-be-true investments, taking a financial risk and large personal loans. The more that you can keep things on an even keel, the better off you will be. One drawback in money matters is that you also like your personal relationships to be harmonious, and you do your best to make your loved ones happy. You need to avoid lending money as this can lead to problems further down the track. As long as you stay solvent then you can maintain a positive money mindset and become a money magnet. Afterall, the positive money planet Venus rules your Zodiac Sign. Looking after yourself helps you attract a steady flow of energy and money, and allowing you to support others.

Let's look at one way of nurturing your Moon and that is through the art of aromatherapy. Like astrology, aromatherapy is an ancient craft. And while nothing replaces a professional consultation, you can explore the sensual world of aromatherapy by introducing some oils via Zodiac Signs. You could apply the following tips to your Sun and Rising Sign as well, but the Moon is the seat of emotions and responds well to positive effects of scent and touch. Also, the sense of smell is most closely linked to memory and emotions, and this connects directly to the astrological Moon. You may choose aromatherapy oils that enhance or strengthen your traits, or ones that calm or soothe. In your case your Moon is in Libra and so geranium is nurturing. Juniper basil and bergamot are useful for relaxing muscle spasms in the lower back. You could also try black pepper, frankincense and melissa for nurturing a sense of self-support which does not come naturally for Libran Moon people.

On another note, let's look at the association between Zodiac Signs and colours. Experts say that colour has a powerful effect on the psyche, that it can be used to signal action, influence mood and even influence physiological reactions. They say that certain colours have been connected directly to calming moods, or increasing blood pressure, and influencing decisions. Perhaps the Moon which is most closely associated with mood and emotions could be the colour of choice for you, but you may also feel like you really shine when you wear or see your Sun Sign colour. Libra is connected to pale pink and light blue. If you have a Libra Moon then you may be attracted to pale colours in general, but pale pink and light blue are likely to be particularly soothing as the colours associated with your Moon Sign. These colours help Librans keep the balance that you so crave.

The Moon is in Libra ...and Mars is in a Feminine Sign

When emotions run high this is usually associated with the Moon and its Sign. Understanding feelings can lead to greater connectivity and improved personal relations. Anger is one such emotion. Anger may be triggered by situations that are perceived as unfair, if you think someone has wronged you, humiliated you or put your social status at risk. Different people react differently to different triggers. You may find that you have certain situations that are likely to trigger an anger response. Everyone feels angry from time to time. But it's how you show your anger that matters. If you don't control your anger, it can lead to negative situations. This section is aimed at helping you understand what triggers heated feelings connected to your Moon in combination with the red planet, Mars. This combination means that you have some trouble balancing your emotions, or expressing them when others are behaving badly. Your Libra Moon indicates that you prefer peace and harmony. Mars in a Feminine Zodiac Sign depicts difficulty in dealing with private matters when feelings are running hot, or out of balance. It's possible that other people's anger and hurt feelings upset your equilibrium. Alternatively, you may not realise the effect that your own emotions have on other people. AS Libra is an Air Sign then it's also possible that you have experience someone giving you the

silent treatment, or even that you have been unresponsive to others when trying to deal with strong emotions. The silent treatment, is also known as stonewalling. And so, you need to avoid withdrawing from an interaction, refusing to participate or engage, or essentially becoming unresponsive when angry. You can negotiate to withdraw temporarily in order to process your own feelings, before engaging again.

The Moon is in the 1st House

While this report focuses on the Sign of your Moon, it's also prudent to look at where your Moon is placed in your Birth Chart in relation to the Rising Sign, which sets different sectors. In astrology, these sectors are called the 'Houses' and indicate the areas of life through which your planets are expressed. The Moon is placed in the 1st House of your Birth Chart suggesting that changing fortunes are likely to occur during your lifetime as you seek the stimulation of different homes, professions and environments. You're adaptable and generally enjoy the changes that do occur, as long as you feel that you're moving forward in your life. You're quite ambitious and enjoy being in the limelight, particularly when you feel comfortable in a public situation. Generally, you're popular and well-liked because other people respond to your open manner. You're a sensitive person who is affected by the emotions other people, responding with warmth and genuine affection. If your Moon is in the signs of Aries, Capricorn, Libra, Cancer, Sagittarius, Virgo, Pisces or Gemini then you may be more timid and less inclined for public life. You're likely to be a flexible person who enjoys change. However, if your Moon is in the signs of Taurus, Scorpio, Leo or Aquarius then you're less likely to be flexible and may have more difficulty with the changing circumstances in your life. You enjoy public appearances, particularly in connection with your job. In ancient times the Moon was considered to be in a strong position when placed in the 1st House of a chart, meaning that you're in a strong position to achieve your ambitions.

The Moon is Conjunct Pluto

This report focuses mainly on your Moon Sign; however, there are other influences that can be introduced and one of these is whether your Moon is closely associated with another planet or point in your Birth Chart. In your case, the Moon and the planet Pluto are connected in your Birth Chart indicating that you're an intense and emotional person, prone to extreme highs and lows. You love drama and intensity, because these give you a sense of being deeply connected to your loved ones, and to the world. It's likely that your family and home life are periodically emotionally disruptive. This can be problematic if other members of your family don't desire the same level of intensity, particularly if they're seeking peace and quiet at home. If this is the case your needs are directly opposed to your loved ones', which may not concern you, but could result in dramatic changes in your personal life. This is also a problem because you've a deep sense of commitment to your personal relationships, and feel betrayed if others don't share this commitment. It's likely that your need for emotional intensity originates from an early childhood experience, probably linked with your mother or another strong woman figure. Your relationship with your mother is likely to be immersed with intense feelings, perhaps even stemming from a life-or-death situation. You may feel positively or negatively about your mother. Either way your feelings are likely to be strong. You're a resourceful person, and can rely on your own resources to solve most problems. You need to find a creative outlet for your intense nature, something that will totally absorb your attention. Perhaps you would enjoy property development, or renovating your house. You're a powerful person with leadership skills and a need for a challenge.

The Ascendant

The Ascendant or Rising Sign, is a key - if not the key - component of your Birth Chart. The Rising Sign is time sensitive and therefore considered the most personal point.

Ancient astrologers believed that the Ascendant depicted our primary motivation as individuals. Some believed that it was one of the links to discovering what makes a person happy. When we're accomplishing our primary motivation then we're happy.

The more modern Esoteric astrologers believe that this sensitive chart point reveals a person's soul purpose. And that fulfilling soul purpose contributes to a happy and joyful life. They believe that acceptance of purpose, or fate, can help a person achieve success and satisfaction, and that meditation on the qualities of the Ascendant can help anyone focus on life purpose. A sense of purpose can help overcome the most onerous difficulties in life by taking the focus away from failings and problems and shining a light on strengths and talents.

Esoteric Astrology, the astrology of the soul, espouses that your Sun Sign represents your personality, your Moon your obstacles, and your Ascendant, the way forward.

The Ascendant is in Libra

The Sign of Libra is considered to be 'masculine' by Ancient astrologers suggesting that you're more likely to actively seek your purpose in life, taking the initiative rather than waiting until circumstances are comfortable. Libra is also a Cardinal Sign denoting enterprise, enthusiasm, self-assertion and initiative.

You're courteous, affectionate, thoughtful, modest and indecisive. Much of your life's purpose is connected with your relationships, both personal and professional. Human relationships are your primary motivation in life. You spend much of your time devoted to thinking about the needs and wishes of other people, ensuring that everyone is treating each other in a fair manner. For this reason, your purpose may be connected with justice, mediation or diplomatic work. Harmony is so important for your well-being. Your fate is largely in the hands of other people. Much of your happiness depends on whether or not your loved ones respond favourably to your thoughtful administrations. You may be secretly pleased to hear that your fate depends on other people because you like to lean on other people, rather than take the initiative. However, you need to be wary of becoming enslaved to your friends, lovers and associates. You would do well to learn to stand up for yourself.

Are you destined to be active, or more sedentary? While the planet Mars is directly linked to sports and

action, your Ascendant can also give you some hints as to the type of exercise that may appeal. Your Libra Ascendant indicates that personal grooming is important and so you are keen to do any activity that helps your body stay in form. You are motivated by your primary partner's appreciation of your health and wellbeing, as much as by your own need for self-improvement. Therefore, you are likely to enjoy any activity that involves your partner such as dancing, tennis, and walking together. If this is not possible, then you are likely to enjoy the company of others in team sports. In some cases, gymnastics may appeal.

In Esoteric astrology the Rising Sign or Ascendant is considered to be more important than your Sun or Moon Sign. Esoteric Astrology is the astrology of the soul, and the Ascendant is seen as your soul's purpose, or the 'sum of possibilities'. The Sun is seen as your personality, and the Moon as your past. The Ascendant is the moment that your soul chooses for your first breath on planet Earth giving it significance. In Esoteric astrology the Sign of Libra is linked with universal love, advocacy and beauty which inspires spiritual joy. Your purpose is connected to helping other people understand right human relationships, or to inspiring others through your artistic gifts.

Your Ascendant represents your physical body, your health and happiness. Your body is the temple for your soul, so your health leads to your happiness, as does expressing your soul purpose. It's also possible that your energy system is connected to your Ascendant and therefore your most potent chakra. What is a chakra? A chakra is an energy points in your body, a point through which energy flows. And when each chakra flows freely, they are thought to bring harmony to your body, mind and emotions. There are seven chakras representing different areas of life and they are also said to be linked to the seven ancient planets and to the Zodiac Signs. Each has a specific function for the physical body, and provides connection to a larger power source. Chakras can have a deep connection to your spiritual and emotional wellbeing. Your Libra Ascendant suggests that you have an affinity with the Heart Chakra. The Heart Chakra is located in the area that it suggests, in the centre of your body in line with your heart. The Heart Chakra is linked with the colour green or pink and is connected to love, compassion and forgiveness. This is the soft energy that is needed to avoid being stuck in hurtful feelings. When Libra is Rising in your chart it can lead to a need for peace and harmony in close relationships, and emotional pain when the scales are tipped towards disharmony. It's important for you to avoid compromising too much. Your Heart Chakra can help you regain your equilibrium. Placing your hand over your Heart Chakra can help you remain grounded in a loving and compassion manner. If you find that your heart is hurting then you can use this technique to soften your heart. Then you can become the true, loving spiritually-focussed person that you are destined to be.

The Ascendant is in the 1st Face of Libra

Astrology also allocates different planets to every ten degrees of each Zodiac Sign. These segments are called Decans, and are sometimes referred to as Face. The Decans, or Face, date back as far as the 3rd Millennium BC, and are still used by astrologers in current times. Each Decan influences your Zodiac Sign in different ways, sometimes emphasising and sometimes adding a different flavour to your Zodiac Sign traits.
